Bunclody Golf & Fishing Club, Bunclody, Co. Wexford

18-hole parkland course. Fantastic scenery, a forest and the River Slaney frame this magnificent course.

Courtown Golf Club, Courtown, Co. Wexford (Tel: 053 942 5166)

18-hole parkland course with an abundance of mature trees and sea views.

Enniscorthy Golf Club, Enniscorthy, Co. Wexford

18-hole parkland course designed by the late Eddie Hackett. Some challenging holes.

Seafield Golf Club, Gorey, Co. Wexford (Tel: 053 942 4777)

A breath-taking 18-hole clifftop parkland course. A test from tee to green.

Ballymoney Golf Club, Gorey, Co. Wexford (Tel: 053 942 1976)

18-hole family-owned and operated parkland golf course. Excellent views of Tara Hill.

New Ross Golf Club, New Ross, Co. Wexford (Tel: 051 421 433)

18-hole mature parkland course with panoramic views of New Ross.

St Helen's Bay Golf Resort, Kilrane, Rosslare Harbour, Co. Wexford (Tel: 053 913 3234)

An 18-hole course, a mix of links and parkland, overlooking beautiful St Helen's Bay.

18-hole links course on a narrow peninsula with the Irish sea on one side and the huge expanse of Wexford Harbour on the other. Beside it is the excellent 12-hole Burrow Course.

18-hole parkland course, with rolling fairways and undulating greens.
